## NATIONAL ACTIVITIES ENVISAGED FOR THE UNITED NATIONS FIFTIETH ANNIVERSARY

*(The following summary is a list of planned and proposed activities communicated to date)*

### ALGERIA

#### *National Committee:*

1. A special course about the United Nations and its achievements to be taught on 24 October 1995 in the different levels of schools and universities.
2. A special commemorative stamp.
3. Panel discussions and special programmes on the National Television.
4. Press articles.
5. Special briefings on the UN and its activities around the world to be conducted by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

#### *UN Information Centre:*

An exhibit focussing on priority themes of the United Nations with the support of student associations.

### ANDORRA

#### *National Committee:*

1. Two commemorative stamps.
2. Great concert of the Fiftieth Anniversary by the National Chamber Orchestra, on the 1st of May.
3. Television and radio debates on the United Nations, with the participation of NGOs.
4. Andorran exhibition at the UN Headquarters.
5. Conference and debate on "Tolerance and the role of the United Nations" at the Andorran Summer University.
6. Inclusion of special references to the United Nations and its activities in teaching curricula of Andorran schools.
7. Competition to be held in Andorran schools. The winners would win a trip to the UN Headquarters.
8. Model United Nations on the theme of the environment, to be held in the schools.
9. A book of general information entitled "Andorra and the United Nations" written by Mr. Pere Canturri and Mr. Juli Minoves, to be published and distributed by the Government.
